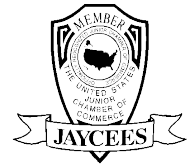

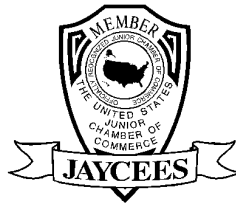

### **Requirements:**

1. Students must be a 2020-21 8th grader, submission must include a copy of current transcripts.
2. One submission per student, must choose (1) essay **OR** (1) video.
3. Essay submission must include the following
  - a. Cover sheet with student name, student email address and parent/guardian phone number
  - b. Essay (at least 500 words and no more than 600 words in length)
  - c. Copy of current school transcripts
4. Video submissions must include the following
  - a. Cover sheet with student name, student email address and parent/guardian phone number
  - b. Video (must be at least 4 minutes and no more than 5 and the file name must include the student's first and last name as well as school name)
  - c. Copy of current school transcripts

### **Submission Reviews & Award Details:**

1. Awards will be announced on 5/8/2021
2. Review of submissions will be completed by the Crescent City Jaycees Basketball Tournament Committee
3. 450 All Tourney certificates will be named making those students eligible to apply for a scholarship during their senior year of high school
4. 4 MVPS will be named from the following categories and each will receive a \$50 Amazon Gift Card along with being eligible to apply for a scholarship during their senior year of high school
  - a. 1 Video – Girl
  - b. 1 Essay – Girl
  - c. 1 Video - Boy
  - d. 1 Essay - Boy
