THIS SIDE IS TO BE COMPLETED WITH A CASTLE ROCK CHARTER SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR The student and parent understand and agree to: Castle Rock is an independent study, home-based, personalized learning educational program (student allotments/no gift of public funds). A Castle Rock teacher will provide 1 hour per week one-on-one instruction with a student and parent/responsible adult. In addition, students may be required to attend labs or tutoring sessions. School attendance is based on completed school assignments and daily engagement on school days (labs/classes). The parent/quardian is responsible for their child's education. A Castle Rock student is expected to be working 4-6 hours daily on school assignments. School attendance is based on completed school assignments and daily engagement on school days (labs/classes). We will not compare our student's curriculum with other students' curriculum – this is a personalized learning program. I understand that Castle Rock will provide Family Engagement Seminars and all students and parents/guardians are encouraged to attend. (web page/newsletters) All Castle Rock students are expected to participate in all school, COE and state and district testing programs. Student support and tutoring are available. Ask your teacher or counselor for information. Castle Rock has a lunch program. No transportation is provided to and from school for Castle Rock students. Castle Rock has limited sports opportunities for students. No school-sponsored extracurricular opportunities are sponsored by Castle Rock Charter School for its students. Castle Rock students MAY NOT be on any other school campus in Del Norte County unless a co-enrollment program is established. Students who are on other campuses may be cited by law enforcement and also face school discipline. Students MAY NOT ride any school bus to or from school. If your student is planning on attending a four-year university or is interested in a CTE (Career Technical Education) program, it is important to talk to your Supervising Teacher and the Castle Rock Counselor to discuss the available pathways to prepare your student for college. I understand that if my student does not meet with his/her teacher and complete all assigned work as agreed upon in the Master Agreement (to be completed in the registration packet), he/she may be referred to his/her school of residence. Returning students: Independent study charter schools must enroll all students who meet the enrollment requirements set in their charter. (EC Section 47605 (d) (2) (A). Castle Rock Charter School is open to any eligible resident of the Del Norte, Siskiyou, or Humboldt County school districts (Charter - H. Admission requirements of Castle Rock). Students that are re-enrolling at Castle Rock may be determined to be ineligible for enrollment based on past failure to attend mandatory meetings, failure to complete assigned work, and/or failing grades while attending Castle Rock. I understand that my student must attend labs/tutorials if he/she is not meeting standards on state mandated tests or is working below grade level based on a variety of assessments and tests. I understand that if my student is not making adequate progress toward his/her educational goals, he/she will enter the intervention process and may be withdrawn from Castle Rock Charter School and referred to his/her school of residence.
